BUCKET BRIGADE RULES:

- Only non-profit organizations which hold a IRS issued 501(c) 3 status shall be allowed to conduct a bucket brigade inside the city limits of Overton.
- City approved bucket brigade shall only be allowed to be conducted at the four way (4-way) intersection of Commerce and Henderson Streets.
- City approved bucket brigade shall only be allowed to be conducted on a Saturday between the hours of 8 a.m. to 12:00 noon.
- No children under the age of 16 shall be allowed to stand in the roadway without an adult accompanying the child.
- City of Overton requires fourteen (14) day notice prior to the requested date to conduct the bucket brigade
- City approved bucket brigade permit must be
- No organization shall be allowed to conduct a bucket brigade for two consecutive weekends.
- Non-Profit Organizations which are not based in the City of Overton will not be allowed to conduct any bucket brigades inside the city limits.

This acknowledgement does not alter the responsibility of the person(s) involved in the non-profit solicitation to conduct themselves and their activities in a safe and sound manner as to prevent injuries to pedestrians or the traveling public. Neither the City of Overton nor the Texas Department of Transportation shall be held liability for any actions or injuries that may result from the approval of this permit.
