GARAGE / ESTATE SALES RULES:

- No more than two (2) garage sales are allowed per household (Not per address) per calendar year.
- Person's wanting to place signs in the city limits from the surrounding county must obtain a garage sale permit and abide by the same rules as the citizens of the City.
- Garage / Estate sales are permitted only on Thursday's, Friday's and Saturday's.
- City issued permit sign must be posted in plain view near the roadway during the sale.
- Free Standing Signs **ARE ALLOWED** to be placed on private property with the permission of the property owner but must be removed by applicant once the sale has concluded.
- All signs, banners or other publicly posted advertisement of a garage sale must be removed by Sunday before 12:00 noon.
- **Per State Law: Signs are NOT allowed to be placed in medians, utility poles or in any public Right of Way (Signs placed at the 4-way intersection must be placed behind the utility poles not in the ROW)**

I the applicant of this permit do hereby agree to follow the above rules and to remove all advertisements after the sale has concluded as required by Chapter 94 of the Overton Code of Ordinance adopted June 13, 2013.
